SPORTING NOTE # 2

Please note the following amendment to the **2025 Pirelli GT4 America Sporting Regulations for the COTA 3 Hour Event:**

Article 12.3.2 is modified to read as follows:

Crew: In addition to Article 12.3.1, crew members must wear clean uniforms and other safe and appropriate attire to present the best possible appearance to the public. Improper attire may be subject to penalty.

a) Mechanics must wear a helmet along with fire resistant clothing (including fire suits, long underwear, balaclava, gloves, socks, and shoes) meeting FIA 8856-2000, FIA 8856-2018 or SFI 3.2A/5, 3.4/5, 3.2A/3, 3.4/3, 3.2A/1, 3.4/1 in the working lane. Fire resistant clothing may not be modified and must display the approved tag(s).

b) Any crewmember, including the dead man operator, the fueler, the vent man, and fire bottle operator, involved in the fueling process must wear a full face helmet meeting FIA Technical list 25 standards and within published expiration dates displaying the approved decal. These crewmembers must also wear fire resistant clothing (including fire-suits, long underwear, balaclava, gloves, socks, and shoes) meeting FIA 8856-2000, FIA 8856-2018 or SFI 3.2A/5, 3.4/5 in the working lane. Fire resistant clothing may not be modified and must display the approved tag(s).
